



2011 Lost Bay Resort & Outpost Term and Rate Sheet

General Terms

- Lost Bay: check in on Saturday 2pm check out following Saturday 8am. Total of 7 nights.
 - Outpost: check in Sunday 2pm check out following Sunday 8am. Total of 7 nights.
 - Outpost guests: please check in and check out at the main camp, Lost Bay Resort.
 - **Please respect Check in/Check out** time to allow us to make sure your cabin and equipment are in perfect condition for your stay, avoid early arrival to save yourself unnecessary wait.
 - **Children under 6 free**, a childbed or cot will be provided if needed.
Children 6 to 16 half adult price.
Up to 4 in a boat with small children.
 - For the months of May and June we will confirm reservations only for full weeks stay.
 - We will place you in a cabin or cabins most suitable to your group size.
 - Minimum occupancy requirements vary per cabin from 2 to 6.
 - No weekly rate adjustments for early departure or late arrival.
 - Additional Canadian and Provincial taxes, added to final payment.
 - All rates quoted and paid in US funds.
 - Final payment made at end of stay in cash, travelers check, MasterCard, Visa, American Express, or Discover
 - Sorry no pets allowed
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Reservations & Deposit

- **\$100** deposit per adult, **\$50** per child, per week reserved.
 - For full week visits during the months of May and June we recommend reserving and sending deposit ASAP.
 - Personal checks and Credit Cards accepted for deposits.
 - Reservations confirmed when deposits received in full.
 - Deposits are non refundable but are transferrable to other open dates.
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Special Discounts

10 percent discount from regular rate, months of July, August and September.

10 percent one time discount to Guests of Record for recommending and registering a new group of equal or larger size, discount prorated for a new group of smaller size.

Boats & Motors

- 16' aluminum boat with 20 HP motor. Also included are backrest seats, anchors and paddles. Boats are equipped with flat false bottoms.
- First tank of gas included with all boat packages.
- Two or three persons per boat with boat packages, four with small children. Children always placed with adults, not in extra boats.
- A charge of \$65 for damage to props. Other damage to equipment paid for by guest at cost.
- Extra 16 ft boat with 20 hp motor. Gas not included. **\$50 per day, \$300 per week**
- Trolling Motor with Battery **\$10 per day, \$60 per week**
- Depth finders with battery **\$8 per day, \$50 per week**
- Aqua View Underwater TV **\$10 per day, \$60 per week**

Bringing your own boat?

- Boat ramp, docking and battery charging, at no extra charge.
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Cabin Information

- At Lost Bay Resort: All cabins and homes are equipped with indoor bathroom with shower, bed linens, stove, refrigerator, dishes, cooking utensils and BBQ grill.
- At the Outpost: All cabins are equipped with stove, refrigerator, dishes, cooking utensils and BBQ grill. Shower and toilet located in a central, modern bathhouse. At the Outpost we ask you to bring your own pillows, sleeping bags or other bedding.

Lost Bay Traditional Cabin rate

Weekly boat & cabin rate, per adult: \$450

Weekly cabin rate, no boat, per adult: \$400

3 & 4 day packages, with boat, per adult: 3 day \$250, 4 day \$335

3 & 4 day packages no boat, per adult: 3 day \$200, 4 day \$285

3 & 4 day packages require check in or check out on a regular changeover day and cannot be reserved during May or June – check for last minute availability.

Lost Bay Executive Timber Frame home rate

Weekly boat & cabin rate, per adult: \$600

Weekly cabin rate, no boat, per adult: \$550

Minimum occupancy: Based on 6 adults to a home with 2 boats; \$3600. Without boat: \$3300.

Outpost Rustic Log Cabins

Weekly boat & cabin rate per adult: \$350

Weekly cabin rate, no boat, per adult: \$300

3 & 4 day packages with boat, per adult: 3 day \$180, 4 day \$240

3 & 4 day packages, no boat, per adult: 3 day \$130, 4 day \$190

3 & 4 day packages require check in or check out on a regular changeover day and cannot be reserved during May or June – check for last minute availability.

Outpost Group rate 12 or more adults; six grouped cabins, max sleeping 25, additional in tents, use of lodge for cooking, dining and gathering, boats & motors extra: **\$3600**

Services provided at Lost Bay Headquarters

Freezer service, fuel, minnows and other bait sales.

Licenses, bait, light tackle, ice

Some notes about the Outpost:

The Outpost is powered by electric generator, therefore, high wattage items such as hair dryers, coffeemakers, electric frying pans etc are not permitted.

Very large groups can use the lodge as their kitchen dining area.

There is a nice swimming area, if you expect nice weather bring swimming gear.

What you should bring - Check list of essentials

- Passport or other forms of ID – Check the latest regulation by phoning or checking customs websites. Proper documentation if you are crossing with a young child without both parents.
 - Food and soaps, bath and dish, paper toweling, salt, pepper and other seasonings.
 - Bath and dishtowels
 - Personal toiletry items and prescription drugs
 - **If staying at the Outpost:** bring pillows, sleeping bags or other bedding.
 - Camera, flashlight & extra batteries,
 - Hat, sunscreen, sunglasses and bug repellent.
 - Wide range of clothing - early mornings can be 45F and afternoons can be 85F
 - Rain Gear
 - Life jacket – mandatory on Canadian Waters.
 - Fishing rods and tackle, extra line recommended
 - Landing net, live minnow container, worm or leech container. We will provide them for fly in guests.
 - Portable fish locator, trolling motor and battery. We also rent them at camp.

How to find us

Lost Bay Resort is easily reached from anywhere in the continent by paved highways. It's only a three-hour drive from International Falls, MN through Northwestern Ontario. This drive gives you a great introduction to the tremendous scenery that Canada offers.

- Travel East on Hwy 11 from Fort Frances to Hwy 502
- 502 north to Dryden
- West on Hwy 17 to Vermilion Bay
- North on Hwy 105... 29 miles to Cliff Lake.
- Watch for our sign on the right, driveway to the left

Fishing Information

- The Ontario government is trying to promote the sport of angling without promoting the over harvesting of fish. With that in mind they also offer a Conservation License in addition to the regular Sport Fishing License. It is recommended that you kill only what you can immediately use. Only take home what you take on any day and keep the catch on ice. For the best flavor avoid freezing and use right away.

Fishing License Information

- Conservation Licenses promote conservation principles. They cost significantly less than a regular license and involve lower catch and possession limits.
- Anyone who is not an Ontario resident must purchase a Non-Resident Sport Fishing License.
- Non-residents under 18 may fish without a license if accompanied by a licensed person. Any fish caught by an angler under 18 is considered part of the catch and possession of the person with them who holds the license.
- Non-Canadian residents need an Outdoors Card to fish in Ontario if they are 18 years of age and over. The sportfishing license tag (1 one year or 8 day) or the conservation fishing license tag (1 year or 8 day) accompanies the plastic Outdoors Card.
- If you have never had an Outdoors Card, you can purchase a "Non-Canadian Resident Temporary Fishing Outdoors Card and Application" wherever licenses are sold. The Non-Canadian Resident Temporary Fishing Outdoors Card and Application does not include the fishing license tag. The fishing license tag will be a separate paper permit.
